TENNIS COURT BOOKINGS TERMS AND CONDITIONS



It is the responsibility of all hirers to lock court gates at the completion of their court hire.

Casual Bookings

Booking of the tennis courts will only be through the online booking system

All court hire is subject to court availability and is available for a minimum one hour hire period and in half-hour period thereafter

Casual court hire payments are required at the time of booking

Access codes will be issued with the confirmation email and payment receipt

If, for technical reasons, you cannot book a court online, please contact Council's Sport Services team on 02 9710 0333 or sport@ssc.nsw.gov.au

Permanent Bookings

Booking of the tennis courts will only be through the online booking system

All court hire is subject to court availability and are available for a minimum one hour hire period and in half-hour period thereafter

A minimum of 6 consecutive bookings is required

Permanent court hire is to be paid one month in advance

Access codes will be issued with the confirmation email and payment receipt

Cancellations

Cancellations can be made online with a minimum of 24 hours' notice

In the event of rain or extreme heat within 24 hours of your booking, you are required to contact Sport Services on 02 9710 0333 or sport@ssc.nsw.gov.au

Sutherland Shire Council reserves the right to cancel any booking with short notice if deemed to be a safety risk to the public. Notice of such changes will be sent to confirmed bookings

Council is not liable for any loss, damage or injury which may arise from the cancellation of any activity, due to circumstances beyond Council's control

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Conditions of Hire

- You must wear non-marking tennis shoes to preserve the courts
- It is the responsibility of the hirer to remove debris from the court before play with the broom or squeegee provided
- No food or drinks can be taken onto the courts with the exception of water bottles
- Smoking is not permitted on the courts or within the clubhouse/shelter areas
- Please respect our environment and take your rubbish with you, old ball cans and empty drink bottles etc.
- At no time are animals/pets permitted on the courts
- Players are to be respectful of players on adjacent courts
- It is the responsibility of the hirer to vacate the court at the conclusion of their scheduled time
- Council does not provide tennis balls or rackets
- A Council inspector can, at any time request your details to confirm that booking arrangements comply with these Terms and Conditions
- Council makes no warranty as to the state and condition of the premises. The premises are hired as they are found by the hirer
- The hirer warrants that it will inspect playing surfaces and facilities prior to each use to ensure the surfaces and facilities are in a safe condition for use
- The hirer takes full responsibility for any incident or injury incurred during the course of any booking
