Business Landscape

Top sectors operate in: Professional/Scientific/Technical Services, Retail Trade, Healthcare & Social Assistance.

Ownership: 49% privately owned companies, 33% sole traders, 18% other.

Employment: Businesses now employ an average of 16.3 employees (up from 15.2 in 2022).

 More flexible staffing models: Growth in casual (18%) and contractor roles (21%).

Sales and Growth



Optimistic Growth: 87% of businesses feel confident about the next 12 months, with a projected turnover of almost 10% above the 2024/25 financial year.

Sales: On average, 49% of turnover is generated within the Shire and 40% of businesses generated at least some turnover online (up from 33% in 2020).

 44% see digital growth as a key opportunity, leveraging social media and websites to reach broader audiences.

Upskilling Plans: 27% of business owners plan to pursue further education, boosting workforce capabilities.

Key Challenges



Economic Shifts: Rising costs (52%), customer retention (38%), economic fluctuations (42%).



Talent Gaps: Skill shortages (38%), difficulty finding qualified staff (26%).

Opportunities

Economic support, workforce development, digital expansion and business activation.
